In October, the Warman and Martensville Interchanges Project continued with road and bridge work as weather allowed. Two spans of bridge deck were poured at Warman in mid-October. Road aggregate placement continued through October and a new milestone was achieved as asphalt pavement went down on Range Road 3044. As the weather continues to cool off, the job team's focuses for the month of November are as follows:

Warman/Martensville:

- Site winterization
- Site lighting installation (weather permitting)

Traffic Management:

- Warman
 - Effective May 12, 2017 until Project Completion – Warman Stage 1 Detour
 - Closure of Range Road 3045 at South Project Limits
 - Closure of Range Road 3044 at Southeast Project Limits
 - Temporary speed reductions will be removed for winter shutdown
- Martensville
 - Range Road 384 closure still in effect
 - Temporary speed reductions will be removed for winter shutdown

The 2017 construction season was a great start to the Project and we look forward to getting back to work in 2018. On behalf of the entire Project team, I wish you a safe and relaxing winter season!
