ABOUT KINSMEN PARK

With over 100 acres of green space located in the heart of the City, Kinsmen Park is Martinsville's destination park. With its array of recreation options, facilities and beauty, Kinsmen Park is a prominent feature in our community.

Kinsmen Park is home to the Martinsville Slopitch diamonds and connected to the Martinsville Athletic Pavilion, Mocon Baseball Fields, North Ridge Community Centre, Football Fields, the Martinsville Aquatic Centre and three additional ball diamonds.



KINSMEN PARK FEATURES

- Over two kilometers of paved and lit walking pathways linked to over seven kilometers of walking paths.
- The paths span the community and run adjacent to four separate ponds adding to recreational opportunities such as skating, fishing, or kayaking.
- A pedestrian bridge over the canal waterway provides an attractive backdrop for the Park.



KINSMEN PARK ACTIVITIES

From sport activities to casual leisure enjoyment, Kinsmen Park is a great meeting place for family and friends.

Amenities include:

- Integrated pathway system
- 9 hole disc golf
- 2 outdoor fitness pods with 11 pieces of equipment
- Park benches
- Picnic shelter with tables
- Toboggan hill
- 3 Tennis/Pickle Ball Courts
- Full Sized outdoor Basketball Court
- Playground
- Community Garden
- Gazebo



THE FUTURE OF KINSMEN PARK

The City of Martensville is committed to ensuring Kinsmen Park remains a natural focal point of the community as the City changes and grows. Future plans include:

- Additional primary pathways and secondary pathways with lighting
- Tree and vegetation enhancements through the park, notably along 10th Ave South
- Increased irrigation
- Skate park
- Outdoor ice rink
