
10th Avenue/Main Street/Kinsmen Park – Pathway Construction

June 2019

As part of the 2019 capital program, pathway construction and upgrades will take place adjacent to 10th Avenue South and Main Street East. The project will include:

- Construction of a new asphalt pathway adjacent to 10th Avenue South between Main Street and 4th Street South.
- Construction of a new asphalt pathway along Main Street East from 10th Avenue connecting to the Kinsmen Park pathway system.
- Upgrading a section of Kinsmen Park pathway along Main Street from crusher dust to asphalt.

The project will include the permanent removal of the fence along 10th Avenue between Main Street and 4th Street South.

When will construction begin?

The removal of the fence along 10th Avenue will commence the week of June 24, 2019.

The construction of the pathway will commence the week of July 3, 2019.

How long will the construction take?

It is anticipated that the fence removal will be completed by June 28, 2019.

The construction and upgrade of the pathways will take approximately 3 weeks (depending on weather) and be completed around July 19, 2019.

How will I be affected?

Residents in the MacCormack Ranch area may be impacted by construction noise during this time.

The construction staging area will be located at the corner of 10th Avenue and 4th Street South.

Access to sections of existing pathway along Main Street will be limited at times.

The southwest section of the roundabout and the southbound lane of 10th Avenue between Main Street and 4th Street South will have traffic restrictions at times during the construction. Work will be scheduled to ensure any restrictions do not take place during higher traffic times (morning and evening commuting hours). Traffic restriction details will be posted on the City's social media sites.
