A) RCMP

Staff Sergeant Rob Eyre, Sergeant Christopher Cisecki (Martensville) and Sergeant Greg Todd (Warman) spoke with City Council about recent activity in Martensville. It was noted that on September 1st a school blitz was run in Martensville and Warman and 18 tickets were issued. Council asked about the relationship between the RCMP and Traffic Services, since Traffic Services began working out of Martensville. Traffic Services are mandated to work along with the City of Saskatoon Police and focus mainly on highway patrol, they will however co-ordinate times when they can assist the local RCMP if needed. Council also wanted to know if it was okay to share information gathered from the Speed Spy with Residents. The RCMP were okay with the information to be shared and encouraged the city to highlight areas where they would like to see the speed spy set up in the future. The data received from the speed spy assists with selecting target areas for enforcement.
