The project aligns with several objectives and policies which are identified in the Martensville Official Community Plan. The approved building permit will identify landscaping requirements.

Deputy Mayor Chillog and CEDM Shewchuk recently met with a doctor who is considering joining the local Clinic. Work continues on the 2018 Communication Plan with the goal to have the plan ready for formal approval prior to the end of the year. Sponsorship Renewals are being reviewed and options are being explored on how to proceed with renewals as well as promoting additional city facilities.
