
Grass Clippings Screening - Request for Quote

July 2020

The City of Martensville is accepting quotes for screening approximately 10,000 cubic yards of grass clippings with a trommel screener at the City's Grass Clippings Site. All work involved in the screening and stockpiling will be solely the responsibility of the contractor, as the City will not supply any labor or equipment to help perform the work. The finished product from the screening process must be stacked with a stacker.

The estimation of 10,000 cubic yards is an approximate quantity, it may differ by several thousand cubic yards. It is highly recommending that interested contractors contact the City of Martensville's Public Works Department to view the site yourself prior to submitting a quote. The City will not accept unit or hourly rates. Quotes will only be accepted for the entire lot as it currently sits.

All quotes should be directed to both email addresses listed below, and include the following:

- Total cost to screen and stockpile all the grass clipping waste
- Make/Model of trommel screener that will be used
- Approximate start date
- Approximate end date
- Working hours (eg. 8am-5pm weekdays. If you would like to work outside of 8am-5pm on weekdays, afterhours access to the site will need to be coordinated with the Public Works Department)

The lowest quote will not necessarily be awarded the work. Schedule and past performances will also be used to award the work. Quotes will be accepted until **12:00pm CST July 24, 2020**.
