You are eligible for the simplified appeal process if your appeal is for:

- a single family residential property or residential condominium; or
- any property that has a current fair value assessment of \$250,000 or less.

The written material you provide for either process should identify why you feel there is an error in your assessment.

An appeal fee has been established by bylaw and must accompany this notice. An appeal against your assessment Note: value does not exempt you from paying taxes on time or from late payment penalties. If an appeal is successful an adjustment will be made to your account, and the appeal fee will be refunded.
