Bylaw 10-2017

Public notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Martensville, pursuant to Section 207 of the Planning and Development Act, 2007, intends to consider a bylaw to amend Zoning Bylaw No. 1-2015.

REASON: This amendment is to increase the allowable height of freestanding signs from 3 metres to 6 metres for Community Service Uses which are located in Commercial & Industrial Districts, at Council's discretion.

EXAMINATION OF BYLAW: This bylaw may be examined by interested persons at City Hall on any judicial day between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Copies of the Bylaw and Notice are available at a cost of \$1.00.

PUBLIC HEARING: Council will hold a public hearing on August 15, 2017 at 5:05 p.m. at the City of Martensville Council Chambers, located 37 Centennial Drive South, to hear any person or group that wants to comment on the proposed bylaw. Council will also consider *written comments received at the hearing or delivered to the undersigned at the City Hall* prior to August 9, 2017.
